

US ARMY GARRISON FORT BUCHANAN INFORMATION ON PROGRAMS AND SERVICES DURING FURLOUGH

Due to the current economic situation based on the reduction in funding associated with sequestration affecting the U.S. government and consequently, the Department of Defense, most appropriated fund civilians will be furloughed one day per week for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2013. This adds up to 11 days from July 12 until September 20, 2013.

Furlough places an employee in a temporary non-duty, non-pay status because of lack of work, reduction or lack of funds, or other non-disciplinary reason. Therefore, The U.S. Army Garrison Fort Buchanan and other tenants within the installation will be affected by this determination. For your information and appropriate action due to furlough days we are including a list of various organizations at Fort Buchanan and their respective schedules.
